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headlong.30But he passing through the midst of them went his way," (

The Second Epistle of Saint John

THROUGHOUT THE EARLY CHURCH'S HISTORY, THERE WERE MANY PROBLEMS CONCERNING FALSE TEACHERS. FOR INSTANCE, THERE WERE THE JEWS WHO STRESSED THAT GENTILES COULD NOT

CONVERT TO CHRISTIANITY BEFORE COMPLETING ALL THE JEWISH RITUALS FIRST. IN ADDITION, THERE WERE SEVERAL FALSE APOSTLES WHO ATTACKED THE CREDITABILITY OF PAUL. BESIDES SUCH TEACHERS, THERE WERE MANY HERETIC GROUPS DEVELOPING WHO TWISTED THE TRUTH INTO THEIR OWN TEACHING. THROUGH THIS LETTER, SAINT JOHN STRIVES TO ANSWER THE QUESTION, "WHO IS JESUS?" THIS HERESY OF DOCETISM TAUGHT THAT CHRIST ONLY SEEMED TO HAVE A BODY, AND THEY CLAIM HE DID NOT COME IN THE ACTUAL FLESH. THEREFORE, IN HIS SECOND LETTER, SAINT JOHN STRESSES FOR THE CHRISTIANS TO HOLD THE TRUTH AND GUARD THEMSELVES AGAINST THE MANY FALSE TEACHINGS THAT WOULD BE COMING AT THEM AS THEY LIVED DURING THE TIME OF THE EARLY CHURCH.

SAINT JOHN THE APOSTLE IS CREDITED WITH BEING THE AUTHOR OF THIS EPISTLE. THEREFORE, IT WAS PROBABLY WRITTEN AFTER HIS FIRST EPISTLE. THE LETTER IS A CONTINUATION OF THE FIRST, THEREFORE THE CHURCH'S FATHERS PLACED THIS LETTER AS THE SECOND LETTER, NOT THE FIRST. IT WAS PROBABLY WRITTEN BETWEEN THE YEAR 80 AD AND 100 AD. DURING THAT TIME, THERE WERE MANY FALSE TEACHINGS SPREADING THE WRONG MESSAGE ABOUT CHRIST. THEREFORE, HISTORICALLY, THE CHURCH CHANGED ITS PRACTICE OF SUPPORTING TRAVELS AND MISSIONARY WORK BY GIVING THEM GIFTS AND HOSPITALITY, TO SHOW JUDGMENT AND KNOW WHEN NOT TO WELCOME THE FALSE TEACHERS WHO TEACH THAT JESUS DID NOT COME IN THE FLESH. SAINT JOHN WROTE THE LETTER TO THE ENTIRE CHURCH BECAUSE THE MESSAGE TO REJECT THE FALSE TEACHINGS AND STRIVE TO LIVE IN CHRIST'S TRUTH WAS SO VITAL FOR THE EARLY CHRISTIANS.

Question: What is the purpose of getting married?

His Grace Bishop Moussa Answers: In our church, marriage differs from any other kind of marriage, be it civil or otherwise, because we believe it to be a holy sacrament. Marriage, in our church, has five important goals: 1. Love - in a Christian marriage you are going to experience 'agape' love which is the holy, spiritual love baptized by the Holy Spirit. It is a sacrificial love which unites the two partners through the Holy Spirit. 2. Co-operation - in marriage the couples must co-operate with each other in all aspects of life. When you share joy with your partner, your joy will be multiplied. When you share sorrow with your partner, your suffering will be divided. 3. Salvation - marriage enables the partners to satisfy their sexual instincts and instincts for parenthood in a holy, pure way. For this reason marriage helps them in the salvation process. 4. Children - children are the fruit of marriage and are essential for the continuation of the human race. 5. Increasing the Number of Saints - when these children are brought up in the fear and love of God, they will be saints, not only in the church on earth, but also in the kingdom of heaven.

Question: In the Bible, what is the meaning of the married couple being referred to as, "the two will become one (Matt.19:5)?"

<u>His Grace Bishop Moussa Answers:</u>In Christianity, marriage results in the couple becoming one in many aspects: physically, through the union of their bodies, spiritually, mentally and psychologically. And it is this oneness which the Lord refers to.



I WAS THERE:

You say you will never forget where you were when you heard the news On September 11, 2001. Neither will I. I was on the 110th floor in a smoke-filled room with a man who called his wife to say "Good-Bye." I held his fingers steady as he dialed. I said. $"Of course\ I$ will show you the way home - only believe in Me now."

I was at the base of the building with the Priest ministering to the injured and devastated souls. I took him home to tend to his flock in Heaven. He heard my voice and answered.

I was on all four of those planes, in every seat, with every prayer. I was with the crew as they were overtaken. I was in the very hearts of the believers there, comforting and assuring them that their faith has saved them.

I was in Texas, Kansas, London. I was standing next to you when you heard the terrible news. Did you sense Me? I want you to know that I saw every face. I knew every name; though not all know Me. Some met Me for the first time on the 86th floor.


